

But come summer, the region explodes with life as plankton flourishes to support a massive population of fish, waterfowl and whales, all taking advantage of the seasonal abundance before retreating south to avoid the ice. For these few short months of almost endless daylight, the coastal Arctic offers a parade of wildlife delights for the intrepid explorer. This book is a timely review of Arctic life in an era when climate change is having a profound effect on extreme northern latitudes.

Written by renowned expedition leader Tony Soper and illustrated by award-winning wildlife artist Dan Powell, this fully updated and extended third edition now includes a guide to the flora and fauna of the Bering Sea.
