It's been 50 years! Writing my memoir, *Taking the Risk*, during 2023 brought home how extraordinarily lucky I – and my contemporaries, Lonely Planet and Moon – were with the simplicity of self-publishing in the 1970s. This was the decade of light-weight equipment, low cost travel and a hunger for adventure, and we all wanted to share our discoveries with like-minded travellers. In the 1970s we pretty much parcelled the world out between us: Lonely Planet, in Australia, covered South East Asia, Moon (USA) concentrated on the South Pacific, and George and I focused on South America, and then Africa. It was the books' words that mattered, not the appearance (thank goodness). Ignorance, in those days, may not have been bliss, but was certainly an asset. We had no idea how publishing was supposed to work so made it up as we went along, travelling through Europe and the US by train and bus to visit bookshops, and being – um – creative, in ways of getting books across the Atlantic.

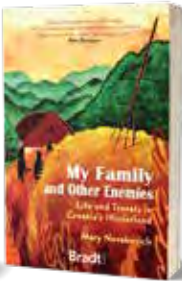
It pays to be different. I retired as MD in 2008, leaving the company to keep its ethos and distinctiveness but be properly run and so survive the 'demise of the guidebook', not to mention the pandemic and other real or imagined disasters. An incorrigible optimist, I never doubted that we would emerge all the stronger – which we have.

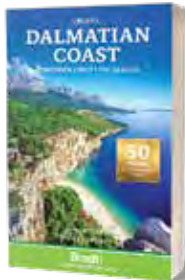

1974

Backpacking Along Ancient Ways in Peru and Bolivia, written by Hilary and George Bradt on a river barge in Bolivia and printed in Boston by George's mother, sells 1,000 copies in two years



1978

Two more backpacking guides, *Mexico & Central America* and *Venezuela, Colombia & Ecuador*



1979

Delphin Verlag buy the German translation rights to *Backpacking in North America*, which Bradt publishes the same year



1980

George and Hilary split up and Hilary continues publishing in England. Shortlisted for the Thomas Cook Travel Guide award for the 3rd edition of *Backpacking and Trekking in Peru & Bolivia*



1977

First edition of *Backpackers' Africa*, which will go through four editions over the next 20 years



1984

A Glance at Madagascar published as a leaflet to distribute to tour operators venturing into this new destination. The first full guide is published in 1988, now in its 13th edition



1991

Bradt publishes the first post-Apartheid guide to *South Africa*, also the first guide written by Philip Briggs who has now written 15 Bradt guides

Bradt wins the Sunday Times/IPG Small Publisher of the Year Award

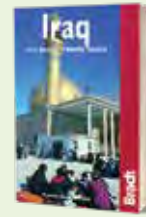

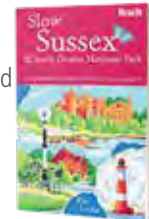

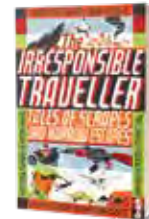

It all began in 1974 on an Amazon river barge. During an 18-month trip through South America, two adventurous young backpackers – Hilary Bradt and her then husband, George – decided to write about the hiking trails they had discovered through the Andes. *Backpacking Along Ancient Ways in Peru and Bolivia* included the very first descriptions of the Inca Trail. It was the start of a colourful journey to becoming one of the best-loved travel publishers in the world; you can read the full story on our website: bradtguides.com/ourstory.

Hilary quickly gained a reputation for being a true travel pioneer, and in the 1980s she started to focus on guides to places overlooked by other publishers. The Bradt Guides list became a roll call of guidebook 'firsts'. We published the first guide to Madagascar, followed by Mauritius, Czechoslovakia and Vietnam. The 1990s saw the beginning of our extensive coverage of Africa: Tanzania, Uganda, South Africa and Eritrea. Later, post-conflict guides became a feature: Rwanda, Mozambique, Angola, Sierra Leone, Bosnia and Kosovo.

Today, we are the world's largest independently owned guidebook publisher with more than 200 titles in print. However, our ethos remains unchanged. Hilary is still keenly involved, and we still get there first: 70% of Bradt country, regional and city guides have no direct competition. But we don't just get there first. Our guides are also known for being more comprehensive than any other series. We avoid templates and tick-lists. Each guide is a one-of-a-kind expression of an expert author's interests, knowledge and enthusiasm for telling it how it really is. And a commitment to wildlife, conservation and respect for local communities has always been at the heart of our books. Bradt Guides was championing sustainable travel before any other guidebook publisher.
